At this point, it is considered harassment, and I do not feel safe or comfortable continuing in this position. While reading the comments online (Facebook – Voice of Worcester page), I was physically shaking and sick to my stomach. As you all know, I am a new mother and newly engaged, and I do not want this type of stress or fear in my life. This has happened with several other clerks and caused them to leave this job due to feeling unsafe and threatened. It has gone on for too long, in my opinion. Perhaps a restraining order needs to be considered.

In recent conversations, I have also felt very unappreciated with the time I put into this job and all the work that it entails. It has been brought to my attention that I am not worthy of a pay increase. This position is a lot more work than I feel the board members realize, and hopefully with my absence, that will be discovered.
