Roads that need blacktop

- South Worcester – East .75 miles
- Liberty Lane – Approximately .3 miles at 4 inches, need to contact Granberg for road bond on gravel portion, current road width is 15-16 ft.
- Crosscut Road - 0.75 miles
- Hillcrest Road - 0.75 miles
- Springs Drive – Possibly do sections

Possibly reclaim in place east of Worcester Road - 0.5 miles

Drive Little Chicago and Cranberry Lake – applying for ARIP grant.

Little Elk Road - Bridge to Little Chicago Road - 1.5 miles at 3 inches

Crosscut Road - 0.75 mile

Highland Acres Road - 0.25 mile

Bass Lake Road - inspect new blacktop and shoulder work - some cleanup to do yet

Musser Road

The 6’ culvert under Elk River Terrace is rusted through entire length on bottom

Musser Road needs guardrail north of bridge

Sheep Ranch Road - inspected recent work on Hardwood Ridge Lane

Inspected new bridge on Disappearing Creek
